- The government can then dictate how and when you spend your money
- You could be financially cut off (accounts frozen) for having opinions that the government does not agree with
- The recent PayPal account freeze of the Free Speech Union is a REAL example of this financial control mechanism
- Once fully digital, banks could order a 'bail in' at will, as seen in Cyprus in 2013. People had 10% of their savings confiscated overnight
- No cash for homeless people and it excludes the elderly who struggle with tech
